- 1953: establishment of today's Alexander von Humboldt Foundation based in Bonn Bad-Godesberg
- international network of academic cooperation and trust inspired by Humboldt's example






- sole selection criterion: academic excellence
- no quotas for countries or disciplines
- sponsorship of people, not projects
- free choice of academic host/collaborative partner in Germany
- independent scientific research, not stipulated by the Foundation





- research projects with relevance to development

Humboldt Research Fellowship / Georg Forster Research Fellowship

	Postdoctoral researchers	Experienced researchers
Duration of sponsorship	 6 to 24 months 	 6 to 18 months, may be divided up into 3 stays
Application period	 applications at any time, doctorates completed less than 4 years ago 	 applications at any time, doctorates completed less than 12 years ago
Fellowship amount	 €2,650 per month (plus additional benefits) 	 €3,150 per month (plus additional benefits)

Feodor Lynen Research Fellowship

- worldwide, all disciplines, no quotas
- members of the Humboldt Network abroad as hosts

- host contribution (negotiated individually)





Feodor Lynen Research Fellowships

	Postdoctoral researchers	Experienced researchers
Duration of sponsorship	 6 to 24 months 	 6 to 18 months, may be divided up into 3 stays
Application period	 applications at any time, doctorates completed less than 4 years ago 	 applications at any time, doctorates completed less than 12 years ago

Fellowship amount: varies according to target country and personal circumstances

Humboldt Research Award (by nomination)

- for internationally eminent academics from abroad
- €60,000, research stay in Germany

Friedrich Wilhelm Bessel Research Award (by nomination)

- for experienced, internationally-respected academics from abroad up to 18 years after completion of doctorate
- up to €45,000, research stay in Germany



Sofja Kovalevskaja Award

- for top level junior academics from abroad
- up to €1.65 million for a period of 5 years
- to establish their own junior research group in Germany
- joint application by the applicant and the host institution





Georg Forster Research Award

- for internationally renowned academics from developing and threshold countries
- €60,000; additional funding of up to €25,000 to support the collaboration
- research stay in Germany
- nomination
