



Call for Applications for Georgius Agricola Scholarships

For a Research/Study Stay at the TU Dresden

Funded by the Saxon State Ministry of Higher Education, Research and the Arts (funding regulations of December 17, 2004)

Funding is available for students of **all disciplines** who have completed at least three years of study at a state-recognized university in **Ukraine** or who have already graduated and want to **study or do research** at TU Dresden. The scholarships are especially aimed at **refugees from Ukraine** (students who have started and not yet completed their studies).

The scholarships offer Ukrainian students the opportunity to conduct a **study or research project** as **exchange students (non-degree studies)** with the following purposes:

a) Participation in classes - course descriptions are available at <http://www.tu-dresden.de/sins> → choose a degree program → click " module descriptions" under "content",

b) Realization of research, a study or project work and/or participation in a research project of TU Dresden (supervision by scientists at TU Dresden).

Exchange students are enrolled at TU Dresden and can officially take exams. Students who would like to change to a degree program (Bachelor´s, Diplom, Master´s, etc.) at TU Dresden after studying as exchange students (non-degree studies) can find information about language courses, application and scholarships on the following website (also in Ukrainian, Russian and English):

Duration of Scholarship: April 1, 2022, to September 30, 2022 (with option for further funding)

Scholarship: EUR 450/month

Application Requirements:

- Ukrainian citizenship
- Bachelor's students with at least three completed years of study, Master's students or doctoral students from a state-recognized higher education institution in Ukraine
- Letter of admission for non-degree studies at TU Dresden (2022 summer semester)

Application Deadline:

March 31, 2022 (Application form only)

All **other required application** documents may be submitted subsequently **until April 15, 2022**.

Please send the application form by e-mail by March 31, 2022 at the latest!
All other required application documents may be submitted subsequently until April 15, 2022.
2. Letter of admission for non-degree studies at TU Dresden (2022 summer semester)
In order to be admitted, an application for exchange studies at TU Dresden is required.

3. Copy of passport (1st page with name, date of birth, place of birth, date of expiration)

The application documents have to be sent exclusively **in digital form (PDF documents, max. 10 MB)** with the **subject "Application G.-Agricola Scholarship"** to the following e-mail address:

We recommend **sending your application documents in encrypted form**, but encryption is not mandatory. Then you can send your application documents as an attachment to the above-mentioned e-mail address via TU Dresden's SecureMail portal.
